1. Purpose

This Policy explains cookies and similar technologies, the categories that may be used on Tectril websites and subdomains, their purposes, how visitors can manage choices, and the rights connected with browsing data.

It should be read with Tectril's Privacy Policy. If this text differs from the actual technical configuration, Tectril must promptly correct the configuration, banner or Policy, as appropriate.

2. Scope and responsibility

This Policy applies to tectril.com.br and Tectril subdomains and digital pages that refer to it. Authenticated environments, stores, portals, systems or specific channels may provide supplementary notices when different technologies are used.

Tectril is the controller where it determines the purposes and essential means of processing through first-party cookies. Third-party providers may act as processors or independent controllers depending on the technology and applicable contract.

3. Cookies and similar technologies

Cookies are small files stored in a browser or device when a person visits a website. They can enable basic features, preserve choices, improve security, understand performance or, if adopted, support personalization and advertising.

Local storage, pixels, tags, device identifiers and scripts may perform similar functions. "Cookies" includes these technologies where applicable.

- First-party cookies are set by the visited domain; third-party cookies are set by another domain embedded in the page.
- Session cookies usually expire when the browser closes; persistent cookies remain for a defined period or until deleted.

4. Cookie categories

Category	Purpose and activation rule
Essential	Security, core operation, load balancing, abuse prevention, privacy choices and requested services. Active only where strictly necessary.
Functionality	Remember non-essential choices such as language or personalized features. Unless required for a requested service, disabled until chosen.
Analytics or performance	Measure visits, navigation and performance, preferably in aggregate. Disabled until chosen when processing is non-essential.
Advertising or marketing	May build profiles, measure campaigns or deliver personalized content. Disabled until specific consent.
External content and social media	Enable videos, maps, widgets or third-party integrations. Non-essential cookies load only after the corresponding choice.

5. Cookie inventory

The current technical inventory must be available in the preference center or this Policy and state, for each technology: name, provider, domain, category, purpose, data processed, duration, activation condition and third-party policy link where relevant.

TECHNICAL VALIDATION BEFORE PUBLICATION. Tectril must scan all language versions and key pages, with and without consent, and complete the actual inventory. No cookie may be declared without technical confirmation, and no non-essential cookie may load before the corresponding choice.

Name and provider	Exact technical identifier and responsible entity
Domain and type	Origin domain; first or third party
Category and purpose	Essential, functionality, analytics, advertising or external content; objective description
Data and duration	Identifiers or events processed and expiry period
Activation and legal basis	Before or after choice; basis applicable to the purpose

6. Legal bases and choices

The legal basis depends on the purpose, necessity and context. Strictly essential cookies may support a requested service, legal or regulatory duties, the exercise of rights or a properly assessed legitimate interest, subject to necessity, transparency and safeguards.

As a Tectril governance rule, non-essential functionality, analytics, advertising and external-content cookies must be activated only after consent that is freely given, informed, unambiguous, specific by category and withdrawable. Continued browsing, silence or pre-ticked choices are not consent.

7. Banner and preference center

- At the first level, show “Accept all”, “Reject non-essential” and “Manage preferences” with comparable language, prominence and ease.
- Keep non-essential categories off by default.
- At the second level, explain each category and allow separate choices; essential cookies do not require consent.
- Record choices verifiably and limit the record to what is necessary.
- Provide a permanent “Cookie preferences” link; changing or withdrawing a choice must be as easy as accepting.
- Renew choices after material changes to purpose, category, provider or duration, without excessive repeated prompts.

8. Data processed and purposes

Depending on the technologies actually enabled, cookies may process IP address, date and time, pages visited, referral source, interactions, browser, operating system, language, session or device identifiers and privacy choices. Tectril must minimize collection and avoid incompatible combinations.

Tectril does not intend to use cookies for solely automated decisions producing legal effects. Any change requires specific transparency and applicable safeguards.

9. Third parties and international transfers

Hosting, security, analytics, content or support providers may receive data when their technologies are enabled. Tectril must select providers with adequate safeguards, limit sharing and document responsibilities.

Some providers may process data outside Brazil. Tectril will use mechanisms consistent with the LGPD and ANPD regulations where applicable. The inventory must identify providers and link to relevant information.

10. Retention and security

Each cookie remains for the inventory period or until deletion or withdrawal, as applicable. Consent records may be retained as necessary to demonstrate compliance, meet duties and exercise rights, with restricted access and periodic review.

Tectril will use risk-proportionate technical and administrative measures, including access controls, secure configuration, component updates, minimization, provider oversight and incident response. No environment is completely risk-free.

11. Browser controls

Visitors may also block or delete cookies through browser settings. This can affect necessary functions, erase recorded choices or require reconfiguration. Instructions vary by browser and device.

12. Rights and contact

Under the LGPD, data subjects may request, where applicable, confirmation and access, correction, sharing information, anonymization, blocking or deletion of unnecessary or unlawfully processed data, objection, withdrawal of consent and deletion of consent-based data, subject to lawful retention.

Privacy questions and requests may be sent to privacidade@tectril.com.br. Proportionate information may be requested to verify identity and protect the data subject and others.

13. Children and adolescents

Tectril's institutional websites are not directed to children. If cookies process children's or adolescents' data, Tectril will apply specific measures guided by their best interests, protection and applicable law.

14. Updates

This Policy may be updated for legal, regulatory, technological or operational changes. Version, effective date and material changes must be communicated appropriately. Changes affecting earlier choices require a new choice where applicable.
